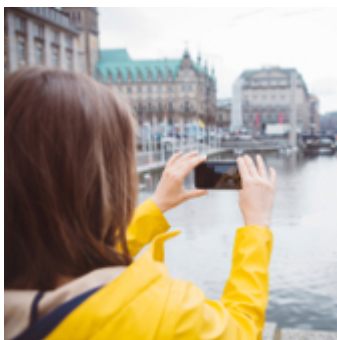


Event Overview of 2020

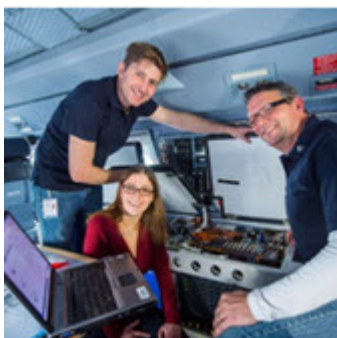
Research Grants

AFRIKA KOMMT! 2020

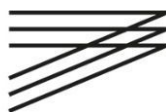
Call for applications
