The winner of this year's Falling Walls Lab Ghana designed a device to help scare pest birds off cereal farms without harming the birds and also saving the crop yield simultaneously. A combination of both the traditional and scientific approach was used to obtain the desired results. Pest birds adversely affect cereal farms throughout Africa (Nigeria, Botswana, Tanzania, Kenya etc) and this device could be the solution.

DAAD-Alumni of In-Country/In-Region Programme from Sub-Saharan Africa

This fellowship programme aims at fostering strong, internationally oriented higher education systems in Sub-Saharan Africa with the capacity to contribute to sustainable development by providing opportunities to alumni of the DAAD In-Country/In-Region programme to conduct, under the guidance of their host institutions, co-operative research at a German university or other research institutions.

Research Grants

PhD options in Germany

DAAD research grants is for excellently-qualified young academics and scientists who have completed a Master's degree or equivalent. This grant can be used for doctoral programmes at a state or state-recognised institution of higher education or a non-university research institute in Germany.

Application opens from 1st July, 2021. Deadline is by 15th October, 2021.

Also check for short-term research grants and Binationally supervised PhD research grants.
