DAAD invites former DAAD scholarship holders from Ghana, Cameroon and Nigeria who are planning small alumni events scheduled between April and July 2026 to submit their applications for funding. What can be funded i.e.:

- \* Events that promote the scientific/thematic exchange of Alumni
- \* Workshops that contribute to the professional training of Alumni
- \* Seminars for returning Alumni

The DAAD is particularly interested in supporting events that contribute to achieving the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Networking and activities surrounding the event are welcome.

- \* Grant size: up to 25,000 EUR

- \* Eligibility: Only former scholarship holders of DAAD (having received individual DAAD funding for at least 3 months) and Alumni associations can apply. AT LEAST HALF of your event's participants must be DAAD Alumni (current scholarship holders can attend, but don't count as Alumni and cannot be reimbursed for lodging and travel).

- **Application deadline: Wednesday 30th January, 2026.**
